



NEW POLICY FOR UNDOCUMENTED STUDENTS

You may qualify for Hawai'i resident tuition
if you meet the following requirements:

- Show you have lived in Hawai'i for 12 consecutive months prior to the first day of instruction and demonstrated intent to make Hawai'i your permanent residence (per HAR 20-4),
- Attended a U.S. high school for at least 3 years and graduated from a U.S. high school (or attained the equivalent),
- Filed an application for legal immigrant status, filed for Deferred Action, or submit a UH affidavit affirming the intent to file such application.

- Sa e aoga i se aoga maualuga (high school) mo le 3 tausaga ma sa fa'auu mai ai foi,
- O lo'o ua maea ona faia se talosaga mo pepa nofomau i Amerika , pe ua maea foi ona faia se talosaga mo le Tulafono (Deferred Action), atoa ai ma se talosaga e faailoa ai le faamoemoe e nofomau i Hawai'i.

Afai e fa'amaonia ua e faatinoina uma vaega e tolu e pei ona taua i luga, e tataua loa ona e alu e vaai le faiaoga i la'u aoga (college counselor) o loo gafa ma le fautuaina o fanau e faatatau i aoga fa'alunivestie.
